Aromas of ripe golden apples, acacia, and honeysuckle are exhibited on the nose. On the palate, the wine is dry, fresh and fruit-driven with citrus and stone fruit flavors.		
Michelle Brut (Columbia Valley, Washington)		26.00
90 Points - Food and Beverage Magazine. This stylish dry wine from the Columbia Valley is gentle and bubbly, offering pretty and earthy flavors, and is perfectly balanced. Perfect for that very special occasion.

14 Hands "Hot to Trot" White Blend (Washington State)	7.99	25.00
This fresh and lively wine is a blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Gris, Viognier that reveals aromas of white stone fruits and citrus, complemented by light floral notes. Flavors of pear, melon and lemon zest are balanced by crisp acidity, ending with a vibrant finish.		
14 Hands Riesling (Washington)	7.99	25.00
Aromas of apple blossom and tangerine, flavors of freshly-sliced peaches and Granny Smith apples with a big, juicy finish.		
Woodbridge Chardonnay by Robert Mondavi (California)	8.50	28.00
This California Chardonnay offers apple and melon aromas with pretty citrus and apple flavors and a spicy finish. It is a delightful Chardonnay from only Robert Mondavi with this kind of quality and value.		
Columbia Crest "Grand Estates" Chardonnay (Washington)	8.99	36.00
Rich and vibrant, beautifully focused to show off its plush honey, spice and smoke-accented pear and apricot flavors. Finish is seductively polished.		
Kendall-Jackson Vintner's Reserve Chardonnay (California)	10.99	38.00
This Chardonnay bursts with tropical flavors such as mango, papaya and pineapple with citrus notes.		
DeLoach "Russian River" Chardonnay (California)		35.00
This Russian River Valley Estate Vineyard Chardonnay glows a brilliant golden-yellow in the glass before opening with aromas and flavors of honeysuckle, apples, and pear.

De Martino Sauvignon Blanc *Organic* (Maipo Valley, Chile)	8.99	36.00
From the Alexander Valley region of California, this wine is very refreshing, simple and savory, oriented towards the green grape and fresh fruity overtones rather than heavy wood. Perfect with any seafood dish from light fish to lobster.		
Campanile Pinot Grigio (Friuli Venezia)	8.75	29.00
Straw yellow color in the glass. Light and pleasant floral notes fill the nose, and a vibrant palate envelopes the mouth. The excellent harmony of fruit and acid give the wine a full structure with a crisp and lively mouth feel. Light-bodied with a long finish.		
Collegiata Pinot Grigio (Veneto)		28.00
This wine is fresh and fruity with clean, crisp acidity. It is best enjoyed young and chilled.		
Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio (Alto Adige)		50.00
A delicately fresh and fruity white wine with a soft touch of sweetness. Deliciously refreshing all alone and a delight with fish and other light meals.		
Vivanco Rioja Blanco (Spain)		27.00
A blend of Tempranillo Blanco, Viura, and Malvasia, this wine is fresh with crisp aromas of green apple and peach backed by subtle hints of grass. Citrus and tropical fruit flavors flood the palate.		
Fratelli Urciuolo Falanghina (Campania, Italy)		29.00
This easy-going white wine shows aromas of fresh-cut flowers and green fruit on the nose. Its balanced flavor is reminiscent of Granny Smith apples.		
Villa Maria Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough, New Zealand)		29.00
Majors on purity of the fruit. Aromas of gooseberries, lime and pea pod lead into refreshing zingy flavors of gooseberry and citrus that have a lingering minerality.

Robert Mondavi Private Selection Pinot Noir (California)	8.50	29.00
This wine explodes with cherry and anise aromas, balanced with generous plum and chocolate flavors and finishes with just a hint of toasty oak. Perfectly served with port, veal and lamb dishes.		
McManis Red Zinfandel (Lodi, California)	8.50	29.00
This Zinfandel shows juicy, bright, red fruits with soft supple tannins. With aromas of ripe red currants and fresh strawberries, the wine is medium dark purple. This wine shows many characteristics of other classic Lodi Zinfandels.

Foppiano “Lot 96” Petite Sirah (Sonoma County, California)		26.00
This approachable Petite Sirah explodes with aromatics of black cherry and blackberry, with hints of blueberry and caramel. Velvety flavors of cherry, plum, and blackberry dominate the palate, while the soft and supple tannins round out the middle.		
“R” Collection by Raymond Field Blend (Sonoma County, California)	8.75	29.00
This medium- to full-bodied wine offers firm, juicy tannins and bright acidity, and is overflowing with tangy raspberry, cherry, blueberry, and freshly-cracked white pepper flavors. Exceptional balance and velvety texture culminate in a lengthy, satisfying finish. A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, Petite Sirah, and Zinfandel.		
Kendall-Jackson Vintner’s Reserve Merlot (Sonoma)	11.99	40.00
Wonderful plum, spice, currant and wild berry flavors, with soft tannins leading to a long, lingering finish.		
Columbia Crest “Grand Estates” Merlot (Columbia Valley, Washington)		31.00
Out of the Columbia Valley of Washington State, this full-bodied Merlot has medium oak, rustic tannins and a dark ruby color. Its aromas include black cherry, blackberry, burnt toast and smoke with flavors of black cherry, dried herbs and raspberry.		
Stags’ Leap Winery Merlot (California)		59.00
Brambly character is evident among black fruit that is enhanced by a touch of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. On the nose, clove, spice and chocolate prevail over black plum aromas. Balanced and complex, this wine features a juicy mid-palate contributing to the full mouthfeel of this rich, seamless Merlot.		
Woodbridge Cabernet Sauvignon by Robert Mondavi (California)	8.50	28.00
A medium-bodied California Cabernet that starts off with a hint of licorice that is found in smoky oak. It is very easy to drink with up-front fruit leading into currant and spice on the finish.		
Seven Falls Cabernet Sauvignon (Wahluke Slope, Washington)	8.99	36.00
Ripe black cherry and boysenberry layered with notes of caramel, mocha and black tea. Concentrated, full body with a smooth lasting finish.		
Robert Mondavi Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon (California)		49.00
This wine combines aggressive tannins with ripe succulent fruit and has everything expected in a California Cabernet. It's all here - currants, berries, cedar and smoky oak with harmony and balance. Ready to drink now and perfect with almost any meal.		
Whitehall Lane “Tre Leoni” Red Blend (Napa, California)		49.00
This ferociously fun blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Syrah is fruit-forward and easy to drink. It's loaded with ripe blackberry, cherry, and floral notes that are bright and silky. It gains some weight and structure from the Cabernet Sauvignon that is balanced by the velvety softness of Merlot, while Syrah adds extra jammy fruit.		
Stags’ Leap Winery Cabernet Sauvignon (California)		88.00
On the nose, layers of black fruit notes with aromas of cola, clove, coffee and black pepper. Taste it, and the flavors of blackberry, black cherry, anise, black tea and dark chocolate are revealed. Full bodied with an integrated tannin structure, this Cabernet Sauvignon offers hints of mineral which enhance the complex fruit through a long finish.

Opici “Straw Bottle” Chianti (Toscana)		22.00
Best known for its straw bottle, this Chianti is always consistent for being light, soft and fruity. This wine goes great with pasta and red sauces. The Chianti Grandpa used to drink.		
Sabazio Rosso di Montepulciano (Toscana)		29.00
Ruby red in color. On the nose, a fresh bouquet of ripe red berry fruit. On the palate, well-structured and very pleasing with smooth tannins.		
Carpineto “Dogajolo” (Toscana)	8.75	29.00
From Tuscany, this medium-bodied wine is a blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon. It is smooth and supple with light oak and aromas of blackberry, cassis and minerals. This wine is dry yet fruity with soft tannins and a very well-balanced finish.		
Luiano Chianti Classico (Toscana)		31.00
This well-made wine shows good cherry fruit and a licorice or mint note on the nose. Round and fairly full on the palate, cherries, plums, cinnamon and the addition of toasty oak. Shows good length and some dusty tannins on the back end.		
Domaine Bousquet Malbec - Organic (Argentina)	8.99	36.00
Intense rich aromas of blackberry fruit with spicy black pepper notes and black currant. On the palate, ripe plum and chocolate flavors with a very soft, supple mouthfeel. Excellent structure and length.		
Tormaresca Primitivo (Puglia)	8.99	36.00
An easy-going crowd-pleaser, with supple tannins and juicy acidity framing ripe blackberry and black cherry fruit and layers of aromatic dried herb and sweet ground spice notes. Excellent with rich red sauces and pizza.		
Viberti Barbera d’Alba “Bricco Airoli” (Piemonte)		38.00
Viberti’s Barbera d’Alba has an intense, ruby-red color and a full, ethereal bouquet. The flavor is dry and full-bodied. While this wine will continue to develop in the bottle, it should be consumed within 10 years of the vintage.		
Gabbiano Chianti Riserva “Black Label” (Toscana)		48.00
Deep ruby-red in the glass. The nose shows intense aromas of wilted violet, red fruits, spicy black pepper and sweet licorice. The palate is mouth-filling and warm, with the red fruit balanced by round tannins, a fresh acidity, and a long finish.		
Cesari Amarone (Veneto)		69.00
From Veneto, Italy, this Amarone is made from Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara grapes that are left to dry over the winter, then pressed, giving it a deep color with a ripe reminiscent of dried fruit, rich texture and an elegant finish. Best Amarone in its class for the price.
